10:45 a.m. – 12:00 noon – Hansen Feeder Canal; participants will travel along the Hansen Feeder Canal to learn more about the infrastructure that brings water from its source to storage reservoirs and then to water users. **Host: Jeff Stahla**

12:00 noon – 1:15 p.m. – Flatiron Reservoir; Lunch – participants will see firsthand and learn about some of the critical infrastructure that delivers water from the Colorado Big Thompson Project to more than a million residents of Northern Colorado.
